The Vista Centre Day Program (VCDP) is a social leisure program where participants spend the day in a safe environment, under staff's guidance, participants develop leisure lifestyle skills, find activities in the community, improve self-esteem, and develop social relationships.

Program activities are designed to appeal to a broad scope of personal interests. With regular feedback from our members in the development of our schedules, we can be sure that program activities have a participant focus.

All interested individuals will need to complete an intake assessment and meet eligibility criteria before beginning.

Eligibility Criteria

- Diagnosis of an Acquired Brain Injury
- Age 18 years and older.
- Individuals have the willingness to increase their independence and express interest in participating in the program.
- Individual assessments will be completed for persons dealing with addiction issues or experiencing significant behavioural and/or psychiatric challenges,
- An individual assessment, INTER RAI Community Health Assessment, will be completed for all new program
