### WHO ATTENDED



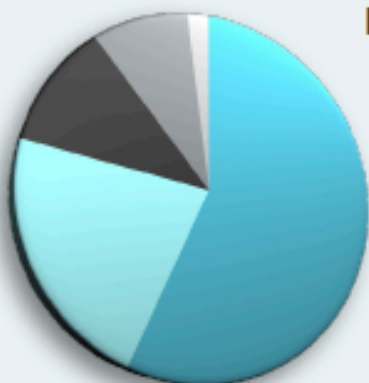
90% were from Ontario
